
## COFFEE MORNING

## PRAYER TRIOS

### Fellow Prayers

Rev. Linda has passed on to me the responsibility for continuing the prayer trios.

For those who don't know what the prayer trios are about, it is a system where people are asked to pray for two other people and in turn are prayed for by those two people on a rota basis. This usually lasts for a period of two or three months. The names of the people you are praying for and being prayed for are only known to the three people in each trio. How it works is that roughly every two to three months an envelope appears at the back of the church with your name on it which contains two new names of people to pray for.

This is an opportunity to support each other in prayer, get to know fellow members of the congregation, to put names to faces, and to build on the fellowship we all share each week.

As I haven't (to date) been given a list of people who are already on the rota, I thought it might be a good time to refresh the rota and invite anyone who would like to join in to do so.

So whether you wish to continue or would like to join this important part of our prayer and fellowship life, could you please put your name on the list at the back of the church, catch me after a service or e-mail on [fastphillipwitty@btinternet.com](mailto:fastphillipwitty@btinternet.com) and I will endeavour to have a new set of trios ready for the end of June.
